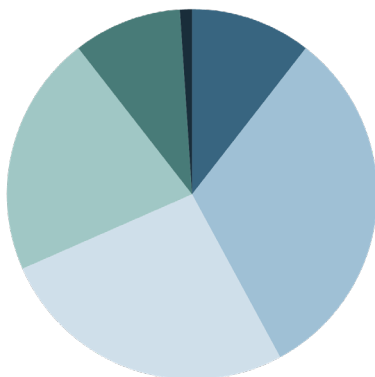
2024 ANNUAL REPORT

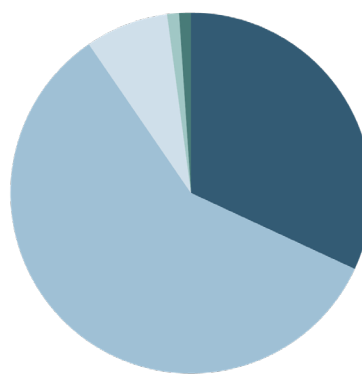
DEMOGRAPHICS OF YOUTH SERVED

2024 OUTCOMES

- 16 years old was the average age in 2024
- 9 high school diplomas or GEDs awarded
- 6.2 hours of treatment services provided per youth each week
- An average of 11 MDTs completed per youth during their time in the program
- 4.7 average family contacts per youth each month
- 9 youth participated in student government activities each month on average
